- [] Electrical connectors reconnected properly
- [] Hoses and lines reattached and clamped securely
FLUIDS
- [] Oil or fluid levels topped off (engine oil, coolant, brake fluid, etc.)
- [] No visible fluid leaks under the vehicle
- [] Reservoir caps securely tightened
BELTS & MOVING PARTS
- [] Belts reinstalled and tensioned correctly

- [] Fan and pulley movement clear and smooth

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- [] No tools left near moving components
BATTERY & ELECTRICAL
- [] Battery reconnected (if disconnected)
- [] Lights, indicators, and dashboard functions checked
- [] No warning lights remain on
WHEELS & TIRES (If removed)
- [] Lug nuts torqued in correct sequence
- [] Tires inflated to proper PSI
- [] Hubcaps reinstalled (if applicable)
TEST DRIVE READY
- [] Car starts smoothly with no odd sounds
- [] Brakes and steering feel normal
- [] No new vibrations, leaks, or dashboard warnings
FINAL CHECK
- [] Maintenance log updated (if needed)
- [] Old parts disposed of properly
- [] Confidence in the repair and road safety
